

FinLine — Important Things to Remember

SKATING GROUP SIZE LIMIT: THE RECOMMENDED NUMBER OF SKATERS IS 4–5.

The absolute maximum number of skaters in one group is 6.

In over-size groups the rear skaters will end onto the car lanes if somebody falls.

SAFETY!

INSTALL “112 SUOMI” (BY HÄTÄKESKUSLAITOS) APP FROM YOUR APP STORE.

Telling your exact location in case of an accident will be otherwise very difficult!

TAKE CARE OF HAND HYGIENE, USE HAND DISINFECTANTS ON THE SERVICE STOPS!

None of us wants to see a stomach disease epidemic (like Norovirus) on the bus.

HEALTH

ENJOY A COVID-19 RAPID DIAGNOSTIC TEST BEFORE THE EVENT.

We are staying close together for a week and you do not want to spoil the event.

IF ONE GETS HURT AND NEEDS NON-URGENT TRANSPORTATION, CALL A TAXI.

“Free” ride from a local may cause displeasure with the expected compensation.

PRACTICALITIES

FAMILIARIZE YOURSELF WITH THE ROUTE.

If you get lost from your group, it is good to have some idea where to be.

DISCUSS IN YOUR GROUP ABOUT EXTRA LEGS EARLY ENOUGH.

Typically, not all skaters and/or groups will go for an extra leg.

TAKE YOUR SKATES TO YOUR HOTEL ROOM AFTER FINISHING THE LAST LEG ON FRIDAY.

Otherwise, you will not be able to join the city skate on Saturday morning.
